- strategies to develop children's composition skills and skills in proof reading, editing and improving
- ideas on how to plan and teach exciting and motivating 'extended units' that will enable you to develop skills as well as provide a range of independent writing opportunities covering fiction and non-fiction
- ideas on how to motivate more-able but reluctant writers, through the use of invented/real audiences and purposes, quality texts, film, 'real-life' experiences and cross-curricular contexts
- ideas for exciting opportunities to apply skills into a range of formal and informal independent writing tasks
- guidance on how to develop an effective plan to collect writing evidence for internal/external moderation
