Even Ofsted inspectors are prompted to look for ways that schools 'check what pupils know', ensure that key content is 'remembered in the long term' and make sure that 'activities are planned to revisit previously learned content'.

This online session will dive deeply into low stakes assessment and provide you with lots of 'low on preparation' techniques to take-away and use with pupils the very next time you see them.
